It is less than 2 months to go till the ABU ROBOCON 2012 Hong Kong 2012. Preparations for the upcoming contest are in full swing in the participating countries/region.

Catch up with the latest news from the participating from around the world!

Brunei

As a result of national level competition held on June 23, University Brunei Darussalam won the champion title.

China

University of Electronic Science and Technology of China won the domestic contest held on June 26 and 27. A powerful player who won the champion title and most prestigious award, ABU ROBOCON Award at the ABU ROBOCON 2010 Cairo will come to claim the top spot in Hong Kong.

Fiji

The University of the South Pacific will mark its 11th participation this year.

Hong Kong

The Robocon heat is rising with the international contest looming on the horizon. The domestic contest was held on June 24. Being a host, Hong Kong will be represented by two universities, The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology and City University of Hong Kong.

India

Robocon has gradually gained ground since 2002. The contest held in March attracted the record high of 66 teams. Maharashtra Institute of Technology, Pune will represent India at the Hong Kong Robocon.

Indonesia

Over 180 teams entered preliminaries and only 24 made it to the finals held on July 1 on Java Island. Institut Teknologi Sepuluh Nopember (ITS) picked up the champion cup for the first time.

Japan

The University of Tokyo won the national champion at the domestic contest held on June 10. They won the ABU ROBOCON Award at the ABU ROBOCON 2011 Bangkok.

Kazakhstan

Kazakhstan makes a dramatic comeback at the Hong Kong Robocon represented by the

enthusiastic students of International IT University.

Malaysia

Since hosting ABU ROBOCON in 2006, Robocon has been a very popular event for engineering students. 62 teams have entered for the competition which will run from July 10-17.

Mongolia

16 teams took part in the national contest and Mongolian University of Science and Technology won the champion title two years in a row.



Nepal

Tribhuvan University (IOE) will represent Nepal.

Pakistan

Center for Advanced Studies in Engineering won the champion title three consecutive years.

Russia

The national contest was held during the Robot Festival in Moscow in April. Don State Technical University will represent Russia for the first time.

Sri Lanka

University of Moratuwa will be a representative team after 2 years.

Thailand

Regardless of the flood that hit large part of Thailand late last year, as many as 175 teams took part in the preliminaries. Dhurakijpundit University won the Thailand championship in June. This is their 4th victory in a row and they won the top spot at ABU ROBOCON 2011 Bangkok. Can they be a defending champion this year?

Vietnam

Over 200 teams took part in the preliminaries held in the South, Middle and North part of Vietnam from April 1 to 10 and Lac Hong University won the finals on May 13. This is their 3rd year as a Vietnam champion. Vietnam has been away from the ABU ROBOCON champion for some time. As a host of ABU ROBOCON 2013, will they rally in this year's contest?
