A much anticipated annual event in Vietnam, Robocon Vietnam was held at Quan Khu 7 Sport Center in Ho Chi Minh City for 6 nights in a row on the first week of June with 32 teams participating. Over 18,000 spectators turned out to see the exciting competition and show.

They are the top 32 out of 273 teams that go through the regional contests held in Hanoi, Da Nang and Ho Chi Minh City in April.

It was Hanoi University of Industry who won the championship this year. They were the 1st runner-up at last year's domestic contest. However, being a host country, they represented Vietnam at the ABU ROBOCON 2007 HANOI with Polytechnic University, the University of Da Nang.
